Mr. Aldren McKenzie, a cherished member of the community, embarked on his life's journey in Talladega County, Alabama, on August 11, 1954, to the loving embrace of his parents, Mr. Tollie Sims and Ms. Eula McKenzie.

Fishing was not merely a hobby for him; it was a profound love that led him to the tranquil riverbanks, where he cast his rod and reel with joy in his heart. Even as his health declined, Aldren continued to enjoy the simple pleasures of life, finding great joy in friendly card games.

On the evening of Friday, November 15, 2024 Mr. Aldren "Gay-Gay" McKenzie peacefully answered the call of his maker while in the care of Talladega Healthcare Center, surrounded by his dear family. As he transitioned from this world to the next, Mr. McKenzie was embraced by the loving arms of his parents, Mr. Tollie Sims and Ms. Eula Mae McKenzie and his three brothers, Sam "Mighty Tight" McKenzie, Christopher McKenzie, and Jerry "Miles" McKenzie.
