



Anthony McCreary

April 11, 1960 - July 8, 2024

On April 11, 1960 a bouncing baby boy named Anthony McCreary was born to the late Edward and Annie Maude McCreary in Evergreen, AL. He was the last of three children born to this union.

At an early age, he accepted Christ as his personal Savior while attending Sandy Grove Baptist Church in Castleberry, AL where he served faithfully as the lead usher. Later in life, Anthony moved to Talladega where he united with Christ Deliverance Christian Center now Victory Church where he served as a deacon, usher, and whatever capacity he was asked to serve. He loved the Lord and served Him until his death. Anthony was educated in the Conecuh County School System where he was a graduate of Evergreen High School Class of 1977. Once completing his formal education, to further his educational prowess, he attended Alabama State University in Montgomery for a short time. While there he decided he wanted to serve his country and joined the United States Army in 1979 serving faithfully until 1992 when he was honorably discharged with the rank of Staff Sergeant -E6 after touring Germany, Korea, Saudi Arabia. Once returning to civilian life, in 1992 he began another career with the United States Postal Service at various locations across the state of Alabama (Montgomery, Mobile, Monroeville, Anniston and Oxford) until his retirement in 2007. Being the working man he was, Anthony continued working various jobs including Walmart and Pell City cleaners.

In the year 2000 while attending church service, Anthony saw a beautiful young lady who would soon become his soulmate and the love of his life, the former Mrs. Robin Dark. Their first phone conversation lasted for hours and after 14 months of courtship it was clear they were meant to be together. On February 16, 2002 they were united in holy matrimony at Faith Temple Ministries in Talladega, AL. For 22 years, their love stood as a beacon of pure devotion and unwavering commitment, a testament to the power of true partnership.

Anthony loved his family, especially his children and his grandchildren . They were a tremendous joy to him. His love for his family knew no bounds, evident in the joy he found in their presence and the support and encouragement he gave them throughout his life.

He enjoyed playing basketball, watching football, and even previously played games which he had recorded. He was an avid LSU Tigers fan, and a Green Bay Packers fan, but supported his wife in cheering for the Auburn Tigers where they attended games as often as possible.

On July 8, 2024, Anthony McCreary transitioned to be with the Lord while in the care of Citizen's Baptist Health System in Talladega, AL. He was preceded in death by his parents Edward & Annie Maude McCreary.

He leaves to cherish his memory, a loving wife, Robin McCreary; five children, Nakeisha Sharece Curry, La'Quisha (Jason) McCreary, Shanika McCreary, Ashley Dark, and Percy McCreary; eight grandchildren, Kaitlyn (KJ Taylor), Shariya, Cortavius, Mason, Jaceyon, Carsten, Roman, and Jaxon; one great-grandchild, Kyzen; one brother, William (Patricia) McCreary; one sister, Josephine (Richard) McCreary; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives, and friends.
