Mr. Aubrey Askew, devoted father, brother, and uncle was born on July 8, 1955, in Talladega, Alabama, to the union of Thelma Askew and Lovie Mae Jenkins Askew. He was the 7th child of 11 children.

Aubrey accepted Christ at a young age and united with Mt. Pilgrim Missionary Baptist Church. He received his formal education within the Talladega County School System while attending Lane Chapel Elementary School, Ophelia S. Hill School, and graduating from Winterboro High School. He furthered his education at Southern Union State Community College before embarking on a fulfilling career in the United States Army serving his country faithfully for over six years before he was honorably discharged. Prior to his discharge, Mr. Askew was the recipient of the Good Conduct Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, and Sharpshooter Badge. His military education included COBET and IH Pulse Radar Repair which led to his primary specialty for over five years of 24J1H Improved HAWK Pulse Radar Repairer. Once returning to civilian life, Aubrey various jobs including Redstone Arsenal as an instructor in radar technology and research in missile systems, International Enterprises in electronics, and Honda Manufacturing as a painter. His dedication to his work was matched only by his lifelong passion for sports, especially his beloved game of basketball where talent exceeded all-a source of joy and team spirit throughout the years. In his quiet time, he enjoyed sitting on the tranquil riverbanks with his rod and reel waiting for the catch of the day. On Saturday morning, June 7, 2025, the Lord peacefully released from all

pain, Mr. Aubrey Askew, and called him home for eternal rest while in the comfort of his home surrounded by his beloved family. Preceding him in death were his parents, Thelma and Lovie Askew, sister, Eva Mae Askew, brothers, Claude Askew, Everett Askew, and Alfred Askew; along with his other loved ones including his grandparents, aunts, uncles, and cousins. Aubrey will be profoundly missed by his family, friends, and all who were fortunate enough to know him.
