Bettye Jean Swain was born on March 20, 1943 and was blessed to have parents, Amos and Lizzie Swain and Cecil and Ruby Twyman.

At a young age, Bettye confessed Christ and united with New Maryland Missionary Baptist Church. She received her education in the Talladega County School system and was a graduate of Phyllis Wheatley High School in Childersburg, Alabama. Upon completing high school, Bettye decided to further her education by attending Gadsden State College where she received her associates degree in business. Bettye later migrated to Buffalo, New York to continue her education and for better job opportunities. She enrolled at Buffalo State University and received her BS degree in Social Work. Bettye worked as a social worker for many years and retired from Transitional Services of New York. Over the years, she did her share of traveling and enjoying her life.
