Minister Charles G. McKenzie "Boobie" was born on March 16, 1964 in Talladega, Alabama, to the union of Larry Neal McKenzie and Rosa Lee Castleberry McKenzie. He was one of six children.

Minister Charles was educated in the Talladega City School System and was a graduate of Talladega High School. Minister Charles was employed at Wehadkee Yarn Mills, Tyson Foods, and later became a private contractor in environmental services doing what he loved and always had a passion for, buffing and cleaning floors. He was very meticulous and detailed when it came to the appearance of floors. In his spare time, he enjoyed washing his cars, reading, studying his bible, watching sports, and painting. He was a fan of Auburn "War Eagle" Tigers and the Los Angeles Lakers. In his youthful days, he loved playing basketball with the Knoxville Community.

Minister Charles was baptized in Jesus Name and received the gift of the Holy Spirit at a young age while attending Mt. Canaan Missionary Baptist Church in Talladega.
