Rev. Edward Ell Turner was born on September 17, 1952 in Talladega, Alabama, to the late Ell Turner, Jr. and the late Dora Bell Kirksey Turner. He was one of five children.

Rev. Turner accepted Christ at a young age and was baptized in Jesus Name receiving the gift of the Holy Spirit at Union Springs Missionary Baptist Church. He was a faithful servant of the Lord working diligently in his vineyard. Later in life he became an ordained minister and was pastor of Mt. Grove in Heflin, Al for several years before the Lord guided his path to become the leader of Refuge Missionary Baptist Church in Ragland, AL where he continuously served faithfully until his passing. He was educated in the Talladega County School System and graduated from Ophelia S. Hill High School. With the Class of 1970. Upon completing high school, Rev. Turner worked various jobs, but in 1974 he made the decision to serve his country for four years by enlisting in the US Airforce. Rev. Turner was a true example of Titus 1:8 as he was a great leader and a man of integrity that refused to compromise on matters of principle. passionate fisherman and loved to fish. He was also a master griller who loved to barbeque while listening to his Blues music. If you wanted a good laugh, just talk to Rev. Turner because he was a big talker and was always laughing and kept you laughing. He was an avid Auburn football fan and if he knew you were a War Eagle fan, then you became his favorite person. He was always humble and respectful to all he encountered.

Early Monday morning, July 10, 2023 Rev. Edward Ell Turner peacefully answered the call of the Master saying "Well Done My Good and Faithful Servant" while in the comfort of his home surrounded by loved ones. He was preceded in death by his parents, Ell and Dora Turner and sisters, Essie Lee Vorns of Chicago, IL and Virginia Turner of Talladega, Alabama.
