January 18, 1949 - May 8, 2024

Ms. Geneva Fomby Curry was born on January 18, 1949 to the parentage of Lewis Evans and Nellie Cunningham McCluney in Talladega County, Alabama. She was a beacon of light in the eyes of her beloved uncle and aunt, Myrtis Fomby, Sr. and Velma Moore Fomby, who had the pleasure of being a vital part of her life.

A woman of unwavering faith, Ms. Curry's deep-rooted spirituality guided her throughout her life, as she dedicated herself to the church and her family. inspector for Magic Chef. Following her retirement, she continued to shine in the education sector, generously dedicating her time to the nurturing of young minds at 10th Street Elementary School, where she collaborated with her cherished daughter, Conswella Smith.

Along life's journey, Ms. Curry was united in Holy Matrimony to Mr. Willie Rogers Curry and to this union came the blessing of three loving children, Tara, Phelan, and Conswella. She loved her family beyond measures and would always make sure they were full in the word of God. She would always say "It's important to me that I am saved." Each day she woke up ready to praise God. She found happiness in studying the word, singing, and riding down the road thanking God with her children. She enjoyed being outdoors working in her flower gardens and admiring God's beautiful creations. She loved praising God and gave Him the glory at any place and time. While shopping with her daughters, they would often find her sitting in a chair witnessing to somebody and testifying about the goodness of God. When her children were young, she trained them in the way of the Lord early and would travel with them to neighboring churches as they sang "I'm Bound for Mt. Zion" and spoke inspirational words.

Fondly known to family, friends, and her community as Momma, Granny, Momma G, Mother, Mother Curry, Genny, Gen, Aunt Gen, and GennyRinTinTin. To her children, she was their Queen. Ms. Curry's culinary prowess, generosity, and willingness to always lend a helping hand endeared her to all. Her lively presence, love for gardening, and vibrant holiday decorations brought warmth and joy to those around her. She was the prime example of "Love is not what it says, but what it does." She would do without to make sure others had what they needed, and she wanted to feed everyone who came by her home. She opened the doors for people to stay in her home and helped raise numerous children. She had many special relatives and friends who had their own special place in her heart. Although a pillar of our

community has gone on before us, her memories will remain etched in all our hearts.
