Mr. Jerry Ware of Anniston, Alabama was born August 15, 1945, in Anniston, Alabama, to Luevenia (Brown) Ware. Jerry, at the age of 80, transitioned from this life at his home in Anniston, Alabama on February 3, 2026.

At an early age Jerry accepted Christ as his personal savior. Later in life Jerry joined the West Angeles Church of God in Christ (COGIC) in Los Angeles California. Jerry Ware was a man of faith and visited many churches in the Anniston, Alabama area.
