Leon was born on May 28, 1937, in Eastaboga, to the union of Leo Cunningham and Lillian Johnson Cunningham. From an early age, he embraced the light of Christ, finding his spiritual home at Shady Grove Missionary Baptist Church. His commitment to serve extended as he became a member of the church choir, Chairman of the Deacon and Trustee Board, as well as taking on the role of a deacon and trustee, always striving to uplift through song and service. Leon's melodic voice echoed beyond the church as he traveled with the renowned Gospel Pilgrim Jubilees, sharing the joy of gospel music far and wide.

His pursuit of knowledge and service led him to join the United States Air Force, where he honorably served for 21 years. During his time in the military, he traveled the globe, earning multiple commendations for his dedication and expertise in law enforcement and corrections. After retiring from the Air Force, Leon continued to serve his community through a distinguished career in Civil Service in Cheyenne, Wyoming, where he dedicated over two decades before

returning home to enjoy the fruits of his labor.

Leon's journey through life was marked by his unwavering dedication to his cherished wife, Doretha Cunningham. Their love story began in Mississippi in May of 1958, where Leon, drawn by destiny, encountered the beautiful Doretha Hanks. After a year of courtship, they united in holy matrimony on May 20, 1959. Together, they built a vibrant family, welcoming nine children who would come to know him as the best father one could ask for. His role as a husband and father was his greatest joy; he was indeed her best friend, her best man, and a pillar of strength. Following countless adventures across the states, in 1998, the family returned to Munford, Alabama, where roots deepened and memories flourished. Leon found immense joy in music, and it was often said that his heart danced to the rhythm of family gatherings and church celebrations. His parents and his church were the cornerstones of his life—a life well-lived, filled with laughter, love, and unwavering faith in God.

Leon was more than a husband and father; he was a God-fearing man whose faith defined his life.
