Born on January 22, 1940, in Talladega, Alabama, Mrs. Mattie "Vera Lee" Curry Taylor was the cherished daughter of Otis Curry and Mary Alice Garrett Curry.

Mother Taylor was united in marriage to John E. Taylor, with whom she shared the joy of raising nine beloved children. Her family was her world, and she poured her heart into nurturing her children and grandchildren. Known affectionately as "Mama" to all who were blessed to know her, she opened her home and heart to anyone in need, embodying genuine kindness and compassion.

A devoted Christian, Mother Taylor accepted Christ at a young age and was baptized at Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church.
