Ola served with unwavering commitment in various capacities, including the Women's Department, the Choir, and the MCB Usher Board, embodying the essence of a true servant of God. Ola relocated to Milledgeville, Georgia where she became a faithful member and monetary participant for over 15 years of Discipleship Christian Church. She remained a very loyal and devoted member who could always be relied upon where she was needed.

Ola's infectious laughter, kindhearted nature, and vibrant energy brought joy to the lives of those around her. She appreciated quality time spent with family and playing "Pic and Pay" a family game she created and cherished every moment of fun and laughter. Her passion for roller skating was unmatched, and she could often be found gliding effortlessly on the rink with her sister, cousins, and friends. Additionally, Ola had a love for swimming, which she enthusiastically shared with her loved ones during her travels. Fondly known as "Trisha," Ola's radiant smile will forever be remembered as a testament to the love she bestowed upon all those she encountered.

Their union brought forth the blessing of a beautiful daughter, Isis, whom they loved unconditionally.
