Roman King, the loving son of Arthur King and Isma Williams King was born on October 5, 1947 in Talladega, Alabama. Growing up in Talladega, Alabama, he embraced his faith and became a dedicated member of Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. Roman served the church in various capacities, including as a deacon, Sunday School Superintendent, and choir director. His commitment to his faith and the church community was unwavering.

Education played a significant role in Roman's life. After attending Nottingham School, Westside Elementary, and Antioch School and continued his education at Talladega County Training School. Eager to expand his knowledge and skills, Roman furthered his education at Nunally Technical College. His thirst for knowledge guided him throughout his life.

An electrician by trade, Roman also loved working on wood projects, showcasing his creativity and craftsmanship. Roman King peacefully departed from this earthly realm on January 6, 2024, at the VA Hospital in Birmingham, Alabama. He was a beloved husband, devoted father, and respected member of the community.
