Samuel Thomas McNeal was born to the union of the late James F. McNeal, Sr. and Annie E. Cochran McNeal on November 17, 1943 in Talladega, Alabama

Samuel accepted Christ at an early age and joined Lanes Chapel CME Church. He attended Lanes Chapel Elementary School and later Ophelia S. Hill High School where he was a member of the 1963 graduating class. He then attended Gadsden State Vocational School of Trades where he studied Auto Mechanics.
