Mr. Sylvester Wilson, Jr. began his 83-year life journey on January 7, 1939 in Talladega, AL to the late Sam Wilson and Mildred Jemison Wilson.

At an early age, he accepted Christ and united with The Church of Christ. Mr. Wilson was educated in the Talladega City School System where he attended Westside High School and later completed his General Educational Development tests before joining the military at the age of 17. Mr. Wilson served 4 years in the U.S. Airforce with an E-3 rank and 3 years in the U.S. Army with an E-4 rank. As Sylvester traveled this earthly journey, he met the love of his life, the former Miss Shirley Broughton and they were later united in Holy Matrimony enjoying over 52 blessed years of marriage and sharing the blessing of six loving children.

Affectionately known as "June" to his family and friends, Mr. Wilson loved and enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren. After retirement, he was able spend countless hours on the banks fishing and working in his garden, which was a passion he relished. When he was not out fishing and working in his garden, you could find him somewhere working on something. He loved to work and, but often times, Mr. Wilson could be found sitting on his porch just relaxing and enjoying the beautiful sunlight with a breath of fresh air.
