A Flawless DANIEL DIVA; Tamzen Nicole Williams Lewis, affectionately known as Nikki, was a devoted daughter, gifted educator, loving wife, cherished mother, faithful friend, and trusted mentor. Born on February 27, 1973, in Dothan, Alabama, to Robbie Lee Williams, Tamzen was truly the apple of her mother's eye. From an early age, she sat lovingly at her mother's knee, where she was introduced to the beauty of music through the piano. Tamzen was preceded in death by her mother, Robbie Lee Williams, and her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Willie and Minnie Lee Williams. On Friday, February 20, 2026, surrounded by the love of family, she peacefully exchanged earth for glory and received her heavenly jeweled crown. At an early age, Tamzen gave her life to Christ and united with First Missionary Baptist Church in Dothan, Alabama. There, she faithfully served as a leader in the youth department and youth choir. Because of her deep love for gospel music, she also participated in a singing ensemble, using her voice to honor God through song.

Tamzen received her primary and secondary education through the Dothan City School System and was proudly elected president of the Class of 1991. Even in her youth, she demonstrated remarkable leadership and excellence. During her high school years, she was actively involved in the Dothan High School marching band, show choir, National Honor Society, Jr. Biracial Club, and, of course, the Science Club.

She continued her academic journey at Alabama State University, where she

earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology and a Master of Science degree in Secondary Education. Her commitment to learning and leadership later led her to earn certification in Educational Leadership.

Following graduation, Tamzen proudly accepted a position with the Montgomery County School System, where she served as an educator at Sidney Lanier High School. She loved teaching biology, chemistry, anatomy, and life science, and she especially enjoyed conducting labs with her beloved students. In addition to her classroom instruction, Tamzen sponsored many student organizations, including ACT preparation, tutoring, and mentoring programs. She also introduced the Science in Motion program to the science department. She had a rare and beautiful gift for meeting students where they were, encouraging them with patience and wisdom, and helping guide them toward a brighter and more purposeful path.

Tamzen later met the love of her life, Derric A. Lewis, and the two were united in holy matrimony on July 2, 2007. From this blessed union came a precious ray of sunshine, their daughter, Robyn Tamil Lewis. With this joyful new chapter, Talladega became home as Tamzen lovingly began building her family.

She later accepted a position with the Talladega County School System and continued her work as an educator at Nichols Lawson Middle School, Talladega County Central High School, and later with the Talladega City School System at Talladega High School. In every season of her life, she remained committed to her mission of building and shaping young lives for success. Nikki continued to soar, creating and fostering opportunities that helped place her students on pathways toward achievement and purpose. Tamzen also remained steadfast in her walk of faith as a member of Greater Ebenezer Missionary Baptist Church. There, she served faithfully in several areas of ministry, including as a trustee's wife and as a member of the adult choir and mass choir. She was also entrusted with the role of choir director for the adult choir, children's choir, and mass choir. In addition, Tamzen served as a Vacation Bible School teacher and assisted with special church programs,

including the Black History, Easter, and Christmas programs.

Tamzen leaves to cherish her precious memory: her loving husband, Derric A. 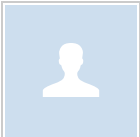

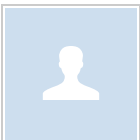
