Born on March 17, 1961, in Talladega, Alabama, Terry Leroy Curry was the son of Dallas Curry, Jr. and Odessa Stamps Curry. He grew up in a loving family and was known for his warm smile and kind-hearted nature.

At a young age, Terry professed Christ as his Lord and Savior when he united with Union Springs Missionary Baptist Church serving faithfully as a trustee until his health began to fail. He received his education in the Talladega County School System and was a graduate of Munford High School.
