Timothy Wayne Tuck began his earthly journey on September 27, 1960 to the parentage of the Willie C. Gladden and Virginia Tuck McCain in Anniston, Alabama.

He received his education in the Talladega City School System and was a graduate of Talladega High School. Upon completing high school, Timothy began working with the State Highway Department before he enlisted in the U.S. Army. Timothy served his country faithfully for fifteen years before receiving an honorable discharge. He remained employed with the Department of Defense in Germany for many years before his health began to fail. While serving his country, he received many decorations, medals, badges, citations, and campaign ribbons including the German Armed Forces Marksmanship Badge in Bronze, Army Commendation Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Army Achievement Medal (#OLC) Overseas Service Ribbon (2), Army Good Conduct Medal, Professional Development Ribbon (3), and National Defense Service Medal. He also furthered his education by completing several leadership courses, tank turret repairer courses, and drill sergeant courses while serving his country.

Along his journey in life, Timothy met his soulmate and the love of his life, the former Ms. Hanife Rustemi who soon became his wife and the mother of their loving children who never left his side. Their love and bond for each other was

unbreakable and inseparable and this was proven to be a true fact when Mrs. Tuck sit at her beloved husband bedside more than three months hand in hand making sure he knew she would always be at his side through sickness and in health just as her vows stated. As he made his grand entrance through those pearly gates, Mrs. Hanife Tuck released her husband's right hand and gave him her final kiss with a broken heart, but knowing he was in a better place with the Almighty God. No more pain and no more suffering.

Timothy was well known for the love he had for his family and his energetic spirit, especially when it came to cars. He loved everything about cars; from washing and detailing cars to driving and buying cars. This was his passion.

On Wednesday, August 14, 2024, Timothy Wayne Tuck traded labor for eternal rest while on assignment in Germany with his devoted wife at his side.
