Willie P. Hall was born on May 2, 1954 at Citizen's Hospital in Talladega, Alabama to the late Mr. John Cooper Hall and the late Mrs. Ethel Lee Suttle Bradford Hall.

Mr. Willie confessed Christ at an early age when he united with Pine Grove C.M.E. Church in Eastaboga, Alabama where he was a member of the choir, CYF, and usher board. He was educated in the Talladega County School System, where he attended Salem Elementary School of Eastaboga, Alabama, Charles R. Drew School in Lincoln, Alabama, Eastaboga Junior High School in Eastaboga, and later graduated from Lincoln High School with the Class of 1973. His work journey continued with Joe Turner and Ron Kimberly where he worked for both guys as the handy man. Willie always kept him a job where he did what he wanted to do. And they all loved Willie!! Willie was a Jack of All Trade!!!! He worked until he was involved in a car accident with his boss where he became disabled in June of 2015!!

After recovering from his accident, he earned the job of becoming a guard at his residence where he sat faithfully daily waving and watching the cars pass up and down the highway until his passing. Willie enjoyed fishing, hanging out and visiting friends. He was well known for traveling many cities in the Calhoun County area including Eastaboga, Bynum, Hobson City, South Anniston, and Anniston, but you could sometimes catch him on Jackson Trace in Talladega. Willie was a sweetie and will be missed dearly.

On Thursday afternoon, May 18, 2023 at 3:40 p.m. Willie answered his Master's call at Regional Medical Center in Anniston, Alabama while surrounded by love ones.
